## **Book Evaluation - Audiobook**

Evaluate the audiobook objectively, whether or not you agree with the author's point of view or style of expression or idiom. Observations and suggestions should be provided on the back of this form and transferred online so entrants understand why they are receiving the scores they receive. Score your responses on a scale of 10 to 1 in which 10=perfect, 9=very good, 8=good, 7=significantly above average, 6=above average, 5=average, 4=below average, 3=significantly below average, 2=poor, 1=very poor. Please consider each topic independently and offer an appropriate score and comments for that topic. It is important to offer appropriate scores on each topic so we are able to determine the overall winners and so entrants can work to improve future editions of their books.
